Our public exhibition space ushers in an exciting time for the gallery and offers great opportunities for exhibiting artists. In addition to this great location, we continue to present our work in other venues to showcase our artists' work throughout Fairfield County.

- Artist talks are offered during each exhibition, usually during the Opening Reception.

Application Checklist

- Coordinate with an Art/Place Member Advisor to assist in applying.
- On a date selected, plan to bring to the Gallery: 6-10 works with their titles, media, sizes and dates created.
- Include a brief Resume, Bio and Artist's Statement about the work.
- Also, provide online images of your works, an available portfolio, and any relevant website information.
- Important: On the selected date, arrive at the Gallery at 12:45 PM; layout/arrange your works

for viewing, and plan to stay 10 - 15 minutes to talk with our Members about your work. Then, plan to leave the Gallery and return at 2:30 PM to pick-up your work.
